Action: the one who decides

## Summary of Forgiveness

Action	Hebrew	Aramaic
Cover	Kaphar	x
Pardon	Kasah	Khasa
Lift off and carry away	Nasa	X
Empty the debt	Salakh	X
Send away, dismiss	Shebaq	Shewaq

**Kaphar**–(atonement) – “**to cover the mouth for the person**”



Leviticus 17:11 NET

for the life of every living thing is in the blood. So I myself have assigned it to you on the altar to make atonement for your lives, for the blood makes atonement by means of the life.

**Khasa** – pardon (propitiation)–“**the fence of support of the strong one**”



Romans 3:24-25 APNT

and they are freely justified by grace and by the redemption that is in Jesus Christ (this [one] whom God determined beforehand [to be] a pardon by the faith of his blood because of our sins that we had previously sinned).

**Nasa** – (expiation) –“**life changed by a strong one**”



Psalms 32:1 NET

How blessed is the one whose rebellious acts are forgiven [nasa], whose sin is pardoned [kasah]! Scapegoat on Day of Atonement

**Salakh** – only used of God – “**the protection of the shepherding of the fence**”



Colossians 2:14 APNT

And he has blotted out, by his commandments, the handwriting of our debts that was against us and he took it from the middle and fastened it to his cross.

**Shevaq** – send away, dismiss (remission) – “**change inside following after**”



Matthew 6:12-15 APNT

and forgive us our debts, as also we have forgiven our debtors.

And do not let us enter into trial, but deliver us from the Evil [one], because the kingdom and the power and the glory are yours, forever and ever.'

For if you forgive men their offenses, your Father who is in heaven will also forgive you, but if you do not forgive men, your Father will also not forgive you your offenses.
